Day 1: Travel to California with meal stops (on your own) along the way. We will check into The Embassy Suites in time for the Daily Happy Hour.

Day 2: Today is Parade Day. Early breakfast and then on to the Parade. When the parade is over there will be a brown bag lunch waiting for you on the bus. We will now be going to Long Beach for a tour of The Queen Mary, one of the largest passenger liners ever built. You'll learn about her history, such as, at the outbreak of WWII the Queen Mary was transformed into a troop ship called "The Grey Ghost", and so much more. Then it's back to the Embassy Suites for the Game and Game Day Party. We will be having nachos, wings, hot dogs, soft pretzels, etc. Food perfect for watching the Rose Bowl game on big TVs in the Atrium. You can take your food to enjoy in the comfort of your room.

Day 3: After breakfast we will go to Victory Park, so you can get an up close and personal look at all the floats. You will be within feet of each float and be able to see all the materials and detail that go into constructing every float. There will be docents available to answer any question you may have about each float. Then we head for home with meal stops (on your own) along the way.
